NEW VICE PRINCIPAL



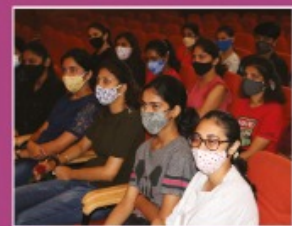

TRAINING ON STUDENT MENTORING

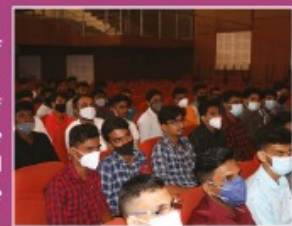

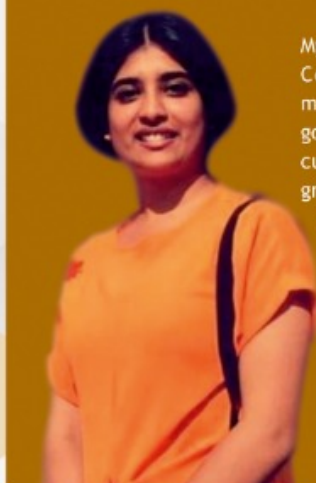
ORIENTATION ON AVIATION
