Event Highlights

• Round 3 – Audio/Visual Round:

Teams identified songs from brief audio clips or visual cues, further challenging their musical knowledge.

• Judging Criteria:

A panel of judges evaluated performances based on accuracy, creativity, teamwork, and adherence to the rules. Points were awarded for each correct song and for the overall presentation.

• Atmosphere:

The event was lively, with enthusiastic participation from both competitors and the audience. The competitive spirit was balanced by a supportive and joyful environment.

• Prize Distribution:

The winning team was awarded certificates and prizes in a brief ceremony. All participants were recognized for their efforts and enthusiasm.
